Substitute Bill Comparative Synopsis

This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill differs from the immediately preceding version. It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same.

Previous Version (As Introduced)	Latest Version (I_136_1719-2)
Pregnancy removable windshield placard	
Creates a new and separate removable windshield placard (“pregnancy removable windshield placard”) to grant accessible parking privileges to a pregnant woman (<i>R.C. 4503.44(A)(10) and (C) and 4503.69</i>).	Instead adds pregnancy, under certain parameters, to the conditions that constitute a “disability that limits or impairs the ability to walk,” thus, allowing a pregnant woman to obtain the existing <i>temporary removable windshield placard</i> (<i>R.C. 4503.44(A)(1)(h)</i>).
Authorizes a health care provider to prescribe accessible parking privileges at any point in the pregnancy (<i>R.C. 4503.44(C)(2)</i>).	Authorizes a health care provider to prescribe accessible parking privileges once a woman is within 90 days of her unborn child’s due date or if she is experiencing pregnancy complications prior to that date (<i>R.C. 4503.44(A)(1)(h) and (C)(2)</i>).

Previous Version (As Introduced)	Latest Version (I_136_1719-2)
Makes the new pregnancy removable windshield placard valid for one year, thus, granting accessible parking privileges for one year (R.C. 4503.44(C)(6) and (9)(b)).	By using the temporary removable windshield placard, grants accessible parking privileges for up to six months maximum (R.C. 4503.44(C)(2)).
