The bill has no direct fiscal effect on the state or political subdivisions. The bill codifies the common law cause of action known as "piercing the corporate veil" or holding a corporation's owners or managers liable for fraudulent actions of the corporation in spite of the liability protections generally provided by the legal status of the corporation. The bill's application is limited to situations where a governmental entity is attempting to pierce the corporate veil. Codification is unlikely to have an effect on the number of civil cases filed nor on the complexity of such cases.
