## DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

<b>Designated Name</b>	"Ohio State Highway Patrol Lt. Vance M. Andrews Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
<b>Highway</b>	The northbound and southbound lanes of State Route 13, between Columbus Road and Beckley Road, in Knox County
<b>Other Information</b>	Lt. Vance M. Andrews was killed in an automobile crash on State Route 13 in Mt. Vernon on November 21, 1945. He had served with the Ohio State Highway Patrol for 12 years and was stationed at Columbus at the time of his death.
