DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Staff Sergeant Melvin Trushel, Sr. Memorial Highway" 1		
Highway	The eastbound and westbound lanes of United States Route 22 between Mile Marker 19 and Mile Marker 22, in Harrison County		
Other Information	Staff Sergeant Melvin Trushel, Sr. served in the United States Army. He earned various awards, which included a Bronze Star, for his service during World War II. He also served as a guard at The Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. He died on July 15, 2009.
