This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill differs from the immediately preceding version. It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same.

Fees	
No provision. No provision.	Requires a probate judge to waive all fees for a certified abstract of marriage if the abstract is requested by an individual experiencing homelessness (R.C. 2101.166). Requires a clerk of a common pleas court to waive all fees for a certified record of a name change or a certificate of divorce, annulment, or dissolution of marriage if the record or certificate is requested by an individual who is experiencing homelessness (R.C. 2303.202).
Identification cards	
No provision.	Permits an application for an identification card for a minor experiencing homelessness to be signed by any of the following, in addition to a parent, guardian, or correctional department as required by current law:

	 A director or director's designee of a nonprofit agency providing services to individuals experiencing homelessness;
	 A school social worker, school counselor, or local educational agency liaison for homeless children and youth;
	 A director or director's designee of either a federal TRIO program or Gaining Early Awareness and Readiness for Undergraduate Program (GEAR UP);
	 A financial aid administrator for an institution of higher education (R.C. 4507.51(A)(1)).
