DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

| Designated Name | "Ohio State Highway Patrol Lt. Vance M. Andrews Memorial Highway" 1 |
|-------------------|---|
| Highway | The northbound and southbound lanes of State Route 13 between Columbus Road and Beckley Road, in Knox County |
| Other Information | Lieutenant Andrews served with the Ohio State Highway Patrol for 12 years. On November 21, 1945, he died in an automobile crash on State Route 13. |
