| Sales of prescription drugs for human use, including by mail to a patient  |   |
| Prohibits <i>selling by mail any over-the-counter or prescription drug</i> causing severe adverse effects in greater than 5% of the drug's users (R.C. 3715.09(B)).  Applies the sales by mail prohibition to <i>retailers</i> , <i>pharmacies</i> , <i>and wholesale drug distributors</i> (R.C. 3715.09(B)). | Instead prohibits <i>selling, including by mail to a patient, a prescription drug for human use</i> if the drug causes severe adverse effects in greater than 5% of the drug's users ( <i>R.C. 3715.09(B)</i> ).  Limits the prohibition's application to <i>pharmacies and wholesale distributors</i> because the prohibition governs prescription drugs ( <i>R.C. 3715.09(B)</i> ). |

| Defines a prescriber to include a dentist, advanced practice registered nurse, optometrist,  | Specifies that a veterinarian is not a prescriber for purposes of the bill, thereby exempting   |
