## **DETAILED ANALYSIS**

The bill designates the following interchange and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the interchange indicating its name:

Designated Name	"SPC Louis P. Shuster Memorial Interchange" <sup>1</sup>
Highway	The interchange where I-480 meets West 150 <sup>th</sup> Street, within the municipal corporation of Cleveland, in Cuyahoga County
Other Information	SPC Louis P. Shuster was a U.S. Army veteran who was working as a conductor for Norfolk Southern Railway when he was struck and killed on March 6, 2023, as the result of a dump truck colliding with a train car at a steel mill in Cleveland.
