This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill differs from the immediately preceding version. It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same.

Previous Version (As Introduced)	Latest Version (I_136_2345)
Instruction on human growth and development	
Requires each public school to specifically include human growth and development instruction in its curriculum and, further, expressly requires each school district to include that instruction in its health education curriculum (R.C. 3313.60(A)(5)(k) and 3313.6034; conforming changes in R.C. 3314.03, 3326.11, and 3328.24).	Same, but removes the express requirement for a school district to include the instruction in its health education curriculum (R.C. 3313.6034; conforming changes in R.C. 3314.03, 3326.11, and 3328.24).
Requires public schools to provide human growth and development instruction to grades 3-12 (R.C. 3313.6034).	Same, but narrows the requirement to grades 5-12 (R.C. 3313.6034).
Requires a public school to include the Meet Baby Olivia video developed by Live Action in its human growth and development instruction (R.C. 3313.6034).	Requires a public school to include the Meet Baby Olivia video developed by Live Action or a substantially similar video in its human growth and development instruction (R.C. 3313.6034(A)(2)).
