SUMMARY

Corrects the scientific name of the Buckeye, the State tree.

DETAILED ANALYSIS

State tree

The bill corrects the scientific name of the Buckeye, the State tree, in Ohio law from "Aesculus globra" to Aesculus globra. Current law establishes that Aesculus globra [sic], commonly known as the "Buckeye," is the official state tree of Ohio.¹
