#### CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following bridge and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers upon the bridge or its approaches indicating its name:

The "Lt. Col. Ralph D. Cole Memorial Bridge" <sup>1</sup>	The Findlay Main Street Bridge, which is located within Findlay in Hancock County and is part of S.R. 37

#### COMMENT

Ralph D. Cole was a member of the Ohio House of Representatives from 1900 to 1904 and a member of the U.S. House of Representatives from 1905 to 1911, served in the U.S. Army during the First World War, and was one of the founding members of the American Legion.
