CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill creates a statutory definition of "microbusiness." Under the bill, a "microbusiness" is an independently owned and operated for-profit business entity, including any affiliates, that is located in Ohio and has fewer than 20 full-time employees or part-time equivalent employees.
