BILL SUMMARY

- Designates the fourth Tuesday in September as Voter Registration Awareness Day.
- Encourages governmental entities to observe that day.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the fourth Tuesday in September as Voter Registration Awareness Day. On that day, state agencies, political subdivisions, schools, and institutions of higher education are encouraged to offer the opportunity to register to vote at their offices and to promote voter registration on their official websites and in other public communications.¹
