### **CONTENT AND OPERATION**

The bill designates the following highways and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highways indicating their names:

Designated Name	Highway
"SGT David Sexton Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>	The northbound and southbound lanes of State Route (SR) 61 between the intersection of SR 61 and SR 113 and the intersection of SR 61 and Mason Road, in Erie County
"SGT Glen Millinger Memorial Highway" <sup>2</sup>	The northbound and southbound lanes of Benton-Carroll Road between the intersection of that road and SR 163 and the intersection of that road and West Bier Road, in Ottawa County

#### COMMENT

SGT David Sexton died while on a night fire mission on March 15, 1971, during the Vietnam Conflict.

SGT Glen Millinger was killed in action on August 3, 1969, during the Vietnam Conflict.
