### CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highways and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highways indicating their names:

| Designated Name                                    | Highway  |

| "SGT David Sexton Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>   | The northbound and southbound lanes of State<br>Route (SR) 61 between the intersection of SR 61<br>and SR 113 and the intersection of SR 61 and<br>Mason Road, in Erie County                |
| "SGT Glen Millinger Memorial Highway" <sup>2</sup> | The northbound and southbound lanes of Benton-<br>Carroll Road between the intersection of that road<br>and SR 163 and the intersection of that road and<br>West Bier Road, in Ottawa County |

#### COMMENT

SGT David Sexton died while on a night fire mission on March 15, 1971, during the Vietnam Conflict.

SGT Glen Millinger was killed in action on August 3, 1969, during the Vietnam Conflict.
