Subject: Creates the Commercial Airline and Air Freight Commission

The bill has no direct fiscal effect on the state or political subdivisions. The bill establishes the Commercial Airline and Air Freight Commission, to consist of members of the House of Representatives and Senate, as well as members of the public appointed by the Governor. The bill does not specify compensation for members of the Commission or whether members receive reimbursement for expenses. It also does not require any agency of the state to provide staff support.

The Commission is to study the policies necessary to achieve the goal of sustaining and expanding commercial passenger airline and air freight service to and from the state's airports and to study what role the awarding of incentives to commercial airline and air freight companies may have in achieving that goal. Under the bill, the Commission is required to issue its first report on these topics by March 31, 2018.
