132nd General Assembly (H. State and Local Government)

This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill differs from the immediately preceding version. It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same.

Expiration date	Requires an identification card issued to a resident who is permanently disabled to be issued without an expiration date (<i>R.C.</i> $4507.52(A)(8)(b)$).	Instead, requires an identification card issued to a resident who is permanently disabled to expire on the cardholder's birthday 15 years after the identification card is issued (<i>R.C.</i> 4507.52(A)(8)(b)).
Reminder notice	No provision.	Requires the Registrar to issue a reminder notice to the cardholder, at the cardholder's last known address, six months before the identification card is scheduled to expire (<i>R.C.</i> $4507.52(A)(8)(b)$).
Fees	No provision.	Permits a resident who is eligible for an identification card with a 15-year expiration date and who is currently unemployed to apply to the Registrar or a deputy registrar for the identification card without paying any of the

		statutory fees, including the lamination fee (<i>R.C.</i> 4507.50(<i>C</i>)).
	No provision.	Permits a resident who is eligible for an identification card with a 15-year expiration date and who is currently unemployed to apply to the Registrar or a deputy registrar for a duplicate or replacement identification card without paying any of the statutory fees, including the lamination fee (<i>R.C.</i> 4507.52(<i>B</i>)(4)(<i>c</i>)).
