CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
"Officer Thomas Hayes Memorial Highway" ¹	The portion of US-33, running in a westerly and easterly direction, between the intersection of US-33 and N. Souder Ave. and the intersection of US-33 and W. 5th. Ave., in Franklin County.

COMMENT

Columbus Police Officer Thomas Hayes was shot in the back and paralyzed on December 18, 1979, when attempting to make an arrest. He eventually died from his injuries on January 20, 2011.
