Subject: Designates the Army Specialist 4 Lawrence George Stapleton Memorial Highway

The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) will incur about \$350 to \$400 in costs for producing and installing a set of memorial signs for this memorial highway. Specifically, the bill designates a stretch on Interstate 90 in the city of Euclid within Cuyahoga County as the Army Specialist 4 Lawrence George Stapleton Memorial Highway. If the portion of roadway to be designated as a memorial highway is located on an interstate route, ODOT produces and installs the signs. Two markers are usually installed, one in each direction at each location. Once a set of signs is installed, there are typically no maintenance costs unless the signs are damaged. Signs usually need to be replaced every 12 to 15 years.
