CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
"PFC Marc L. Cole Memorial Highway"	The portion of State Route 55 commencing at the intersection of State Route 55 and State Route 571 and extending to the intersection of that route and State Route 48 in Miami County.

PFC Marc L. Cole was killed in the terrorist bombing of the United States Marine barracks in Beirut, Lebanon, on October 23, 1983.
