VETO MESSAGE

**STATEMENT OF THE REASONS FOR THE VETO OF
AMENDED SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 286**

January 3, 2023

Pursuant to Article II, Section 16, of the Ohio Constitution, which states that the Governor may disapprove of any bill, I hereby disapprove of Amended Substitute House Bill 286 and set forth the following reasons for so doing as it is not in the best interest of Ohioans.

Amended Substitute House Bill 286 (HB 286) is very similar to provisions that I vetoed previously. The language as drafted in HB 286 is simply too broad.

For the reasons set forth above, this veto is in the public interest.
