#### **SUMMARY**

- Appropriates for FY 2021 a total of \$556.9 million for grants to businesses and child care providers impacted by COVID-19, for food assistance and other assistance programs, and for local fairs and Ohio Veterans Homes.
- Reappropriates for FY 2022 amounts remaining in the Coronavirus Relief Fund at the end of FY 2021.

### FY 2021 appropriations

The act appropriates money for FY 2021 from various funds, as follows:

Development Services Agency <sup>1</sup>	\$180 million (Fund 5CV1)	1. \$20 million for grants of \$10,000, \$20,000, or \$30,000 to entertainment venues impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. Awards must be based on factors such as demonstrated loss of revenue due to canceled events or performances.

		2. \$10 million for \$10,000 relief grants to new businesses opened after January 1, 2020.		
		3. \$150 million for a small business grant relief program established by Controlling Board action in October 2020, to provide \$10,000 grants to applicants who applied before December 12, 2020, but whose requests were not funded.

Department of Job and Family Services <sup>3</sup>	\$319.2 million (Federal Fund Group)	1. \$44.8 million (Fund 3H70) for payments to child care providers (licensed day-care centers and Type A and Type B family day-care homes) for ongoing infrastructure costs and to help with various COVID-related expenses.		
		2. \$67.4 million (Fund 3H70) for child care staff and administrator stipends, retroactive to October 1, 2020.		
		3. Up to \$55 million (Fund 3H70) for direct care payments to licensed providers serving children eligible for publicly funded child care.		
		4. \$21 million (Fund 3840) to support the Pandemic-Electronic Benefit Transfer Program to provide children with SNAP benefits.		
		5. \$10 million (Fund 3A20) to support food banks.		
		6. \$26 million (Fund 3N00) to provide Youth Services Program support in the Educational Training Voucher Program, the Chaffee Independent Living Program, and the Bridges Program.		
		7. \$41 million (Fund 3V40) to support the Unemployment Compensation and Pandemic Unemployment Assistance Programs.

		8. \$34 million (Fund 3V60) to the TANF Block Grant to be used to provide support to counties consistent with federal guidelines.	
		9. \$20 million (Fund 3F01) to the Medicaid Program Support-Federal line item.	
Department of Agriculture <sup>4</sup>	\$4.7 million (GRF)	Local Fairs line item.	
Department of Veterans Services <sup>5</sup>	\$3.0 million (Fund 5CV1)	COVID Safety – Ohio Veterans Homes line item.	

## FY 2022 reappropriation from Coronavirus Relief Fund

Finally, the act reappropriates leftover amounts in the Coronavirus Relief Fund at the end of FY 2021 to FY 2022.<sup>6</sup> This fund contains Ohio's share of federal CARES Act<sup>7</sup> moneys and must be used for necessary expenditures incurred due to COVID-19.
