The bill has no apparent direct fiscal effect on the state or political subdivisions. It modifies the requirements and processes by which an owner must abide in order to enforce a lien on personal property stored in a self-storage facility. In particular, the bill changes notification requirements before the owner can enforce a lien, expands the class of persons who may enforce liens, and makes other changes regarding the sale of personal property in a self-storage facility for the satisfaction of amounts due the facility.
