License Plate	Recovery is Beautiful license plate, which must display an appropriate logo and words approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles and jointly selected by:	
	1. The National Alliance on Mental Illness of Ohio (NAMI);	
	2. The Ohio Citizen Advocates for Addiction Recovery (OCAAR);3. The Ohio Peer Recovery Organizations (Ohio PRO);	
	4. The Ohio Council; and	
	5. The Ohio Association of County Behavioral Health Authorities (OACBHA). ¹	
Recipients	Available to all applicants.	
Eligible Vehicles	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or	
	other vehicle approved by the Registrar.	
Contribution;	\$20 required contribution.	
Contribution; Additional BMV Fee; Use of Contribution	<u> </u>

Requirements for Issuance	Submission of an application;	
	2. Payment of the regular license tax, any local tax, contribution, administrative fee, any special reserved license plate fee if necessary; and	
	3. Compliance with all other relevant laws relating to motor vehicle registration.	
Combined with Special Reserved License Plate	May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law.
