The bill does not have a direct fiscal effect on the state or political subdivisions. The bill requires pipeline operators of any interstate hazardous liquid pipeline or interstate gas pipeline that is within 660 feet of public improvements and developments that require excavation to provide certain information, including primary contact information for the project area, to public authorities or developers of the improvement or project. It also requires public authorities and developers to include in the improvement's or development's plans and specifications the information provided from the pipeline operators and other information. Additionally, the bill allows a public authority to withhold approval of a project until the requirements of the bill are satisfied by the developer and utility. Lastly, the bill designates the month of April as "Ohio Work Zone Safety Awareness Month."
