Synopsis of House Committee Amendments

(This synopsis does not address amendments that may have been adopted on the House Floor.)

S.B. 160 of the 134th General Assembly

House Armed Services and Veterans Affairs

Requires that notifications required under the bill, by long-term care, hospice care, and nursing homes, or upon hospital discharge, also be provided to a spouse, surviving spouse, or representative of a veteran.

Requires the Medicaid Director to provide to a veteran who has submitted an application for the Medicaid program, information about the county veterans service office that can assist with investigating and applying for benefits through the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs.

Requires the Bureau of Motor Vehicles to provide, to a county veterans service commission, or to a member of the General Assembly, upon request, the names and addresses of individuals for whom the Bureau has issued a driver's license, commercial driver's license, or state identification card that indicates that the licensee or cardholder is a veteran, active duty, or reservist of the U.S. Armed Forces.
