This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill differs from the immediately preceding version. It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same.

Previous Version (As Introduced)	Latest Version (I_134_2610)
Emergency resolutions	
During an emergency declared by a township: <ul style="list-style-type: none">Allows the board of township trustees to conduct and attend meetings via electronic means; andAllows the board of township trustees to adopt a resolution establishing a curfew during the emergency period. (<i>R.C. 505.82, 505.821, and 505.89.</i>)	No provision.
Township preservation commissions	
Allows a township to establish a preservation commission to preserve historic properties in the unincorporated territory of the township (<i>R.C. 511.51, 511.52, and 511.53.</i>)	No provision.
School property tax for SROs	
Authorizes school districts to levy property taxes for the sole purpose of contracting for school resource officers (SROs) (<i>R.C. 5705.21.</i>)	No provision.

Previous Version (As Introduced)	Latest Version (I_134_2610)
Township or municipal property tax for SROs	
Authorizes municipalities and townships to levy property taxes to provide for SRO services for school districts located within their territory (<i>R.C. 5705.231</i>).	No provision.
