DETAILED ANALYSIS

License Plate	Playhouse Square license plate, which must display an appropriate logo and words selected by the Board of Trustees of Playhouse Square in Cleveland, Ohio and approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles. ¹	
Recipients	Available to all applicants.	
Eligible Vehicles	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar.	
Contribution; Additional BMV Fee; Use of Contribution	\$15 required contribution. \$10 additional administrative BMV fee. Contributions must be paid to Playhouse Square, in Cleveland, which must use the contributions to further its mission of presenting and producing a wide variety of quality performing arts, advancing arts education, and creating a superior destination for entertainment, business, and residential living. ²

Requirements for Issuance	 Submission of an application; Payment of the regular license tax, any local tax, contribution, administrative fee, any special reserved license plate fee if necessary; and Compliance with all other relevant laws relating to motor vehicle registration.
Combined with Special Reserved License Plate	May be combined with a special reserved license plate as provided in current law.
