Designation	Yellow Ribbon Day <sup>1</sup>
Date	April 9
Other Information	In honor of United States Army Staff Sergeant Keith Matthew "Matt" Maupin who, on April 9, 2004, became the first prisoner of war in Operation Iraqi Freedom. The yellow ribbon, often displayed on clothing or on a tree, symbolizes support for members of the armed forces and unites U.S. citizens in their support for both members of the armed forces and their families. The dedication and sacrifices made by current active duty troops is recognized and honored.
