SUMMARY

- Expresses the General Assembly's intent to support strong foundations for mothers and babies in order to address maternal and infant mortality and improve health and developmental outcomes.
- Designates the legislation as the "Strong Foundations Act."

DETAILED ANALYSIS

Strong foundations for mothers and babies

The bill enacts the "Strong Foundations Act." The bill states that it is the intent of the 135th General Assembly to do the following:¹

- Support strong foundations for Ohio mothers and babies in their first 1,000 days to address maternal and infant mortality; and
- Improve health and developmental outcomes for babies, mothers, and families by expanding prenatal, postnatal, and infant and toddler services and supports.
