### DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

<b>Designated Name</b>	"Army Sgt. Ronnie Blair Memorial Highway" <sup>1</sup>
<b>Highway</b>	The portion of S.R. 66 between mile marker 29 and mile marker 32, in Auglaize County
<b>Other Information</b>	Sgt. Blair was a squad leader in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam War. Sgt. Blair was killed in action on October 10, 1968, while successfully saving two of his comrades.
