BILL SUMMARY

- Requires a public authority to consider all piping materials for the construction, development, maintenance, rebuilding, improvement, repair, or operation of a state-funded water or waste water project that meet the engineering specifications for the project, as determined by the design engineer.

CONTENT AND OPERATION

For the construction, development, maintenance, rebuilding, improvement, repair, or operation of a water or waste water project that receives any state funding, the bill requires a public authority to consider all piping materials that meet engineering specifications for the project as determined by the design engineer. The bill specifies that the design engineer must be a professional engineer who is registered with the State Board of Registration for Professional Engineers and Surveyors.¹

For purposes of the bill, a "public authority" means the state, a county, municipal corporation, water or sewer district, school district, or other political subdivision, or any public agency, authority, board, commission, instrumentality, or special purpose district of the state or of a political subdivision.²
