Sub. Bill Comparative Synopsis

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## H.B. 675

132nd General Assembly (H. State and Local Government)

This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill differs from the immediately preceding version. It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same.

Торіс	Previous Version (As Introduced)	Sub. Version (L_132_1022-1)
Purpose	Specifies that the primary objective of the program is to improve the oral health of school-age children ( <i>R.C. 749.40(B)</i> ).	Same, but also provides that the program may be used to create "systematic efficiencies by leveraging available Medicaid and insurance funding to provide early dental care and thereby improve future health outcomes and minimize the inevitable healthcare costs associated with bad oral health that will be paid by future taxpayers" ( <i>R.C. 307.601(A) and 749.40(A)</i> ).
Dental care for elderly persons	No provision.	Allows Hope for a Smile buses to be used in providing dental services to elderly persons ( <i>R.C. 307.601(D) and 749.40(D)</i> ).

Торіс	Previous Version (As Introduced)	Sub. Version (L_132_1022-1)
Funding	Authorizes municipal corporations to levy an unvoted property tax levy not exceeding one mill per dollar of taxable value (0.1%) to fund the program ( <i>R.C. 749.40(A) and 5705.06(H)</i> ).	Same, but also authorizes municipal corporations and counties to allocate revenue from a new or existing voted health or human services property tax levy ( <i>R.C. 307.601(B) and 749.40(B)(2)</i> ).
County Hope for a Smile programs	No provision.	Authorizes counties to create a Hope for a Smile Program in the same manner and for the same purposes as the municipal program authorized by the bill, except that counties would not be permitted to levy an unvoted property tax to fund the program <i>(R.C. 307.601).</i>

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
