CONTENT AND OPERATION

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
"James H. Hough Memorial Highway" ¹	The southbound lane of I-71, commencing at mile marker 102 and proceeding to mile marker 100, in Franklin County

COMMENT

James H. Hough was an employee with the Ohio Department of Transportation who was struck and killed by a car on September 16, 1980, while he was working on the portion of highway where I-71 meets I-270.
