Summary

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	Highway
"Lance Corporal James Sprowl Memorial Highway" ¹	The northbound and southbound lanes of State Route 99, between the intersection of that route and County Road 64 and the intersection of that route and County Road 119, in Huron County.

Comment

Lance Corporal James Sprowl, from Monroeville, served in Vietnam, and was killed in action in Quang Tri in 1968. He was posthumously honored with the Purple Heart and Bronze Star.
