Detailed Analysis

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

| Designated Name | "Catawba Island Township Veterans Memorial Highway" ¹ |

| Highway | The portion of the road known as State Route (SR) 53, commencing at the intersection of that route and Water Street and proceeding in a southerly direction to the Catawba Island Township line in Ottawa County. |

Subject to approval by the Director in relation to the signage and placement, the bill authorizes the Catawba Island Township Board of Trustees to erect auxiliary markers displaying the following names (and any other name of a U.S. military veteran approved by the Board): Private First Class William E. Galloway, and SP4 James M. Davenport.
