## **Detailed Analysis**

License Plate	<b>Zero</b> license plate, inscribed with the words and markings selected and designed by Zero, The End of Prostate Cancer, Incorporated, and that are approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles. <sup>1</sup>	
Recipients	Available to all applicants.	
Eligible Vehicles	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar.	
Contribution; Additional BMV Fee; Use of Contribution	<ul> <li>\$25 required contribution.</li> <li>\$10 additional administrative BMV fee.</li> <li>Zero, The End of Prostate Cancer, Incorporated, must use the contributions to raise awareness of prostate cancer, to support research to end prostate cancer, and to support prostate cancer patients and their families.<sup>2</sup></li> </ul>	
Requirements for Issuance	<ol> <li>Submission of an application;</li> <li>Payment of the regular license tax, any local tax, contribution, administrative fee, any special reserved license plate fee if necessary; and</li> <li>Compliance with all other relevant laws relating to motor vehicle registration.</li> </ol>	
Combined with Special Reserved License Plate	May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law.
