Detailed Analysis

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"SFC Charles E. Carpenter Memorial Highway" ¹
Highway	The portion of State Route 122, running in an easterly and westerly direction, between the intersection of that route and Wicoff Street (in Butler County) and the intersection of that route and Towne Boulevard (in Warren County).
Other Information	SFC Charles E. Carpenter was killed by small-arms fire during a hostile conflict on February 24, 1969, during the Vietnam War. It was SFC Carpenter's third tour of duty.
