Summary

Expands township authority to regulate noise anywhere within the unincorporated territory of the township.

Detailed Analysis

Township noise regulation

The bill expands current township authority to regulate noise within the unincorporated territory of a township to allow townships to adopt regulations and orders necessary to control noise generated anywhere within the unincorporated territory. Under current law, a board of township trustees may regulate noise within the unincorporated territory if it is generated at any premises to which a D liquor permit has been issued or it is generated within any areas zoned for residential use.¹
