Highlights

 Reimbursement of the actual and necessary expenses incurred by members of the task force created by the bill and provision of meeting space and staff and administrative support will result in a minimal increase in state costs.

Detailed Analysis

The bill establishes the Alzheimer's Disease and Related Dementias Task Force. The members of the task force are to serve without compensation, except for reimbursement of the actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their official duties. These reimbursements will result in a minimal increase in state costs, presumably paid from either the Department of Aging's or the Department of Health's budget. The Department of Aging must also provide meeting space and staff and administrative support for the task force. The task force is to submit its report within 18 months of the effective date of the bill, and then cease operations.
