Previous Version (As Introduced)	Latest Version (I_133_0482-1)
Academic distress commission	
Prohibits the Superintendent of Public Instruction from creating any new public academic distress commissions. (<i>R.C. 3302.103</i>)	No provision.
No Provision.	Repeals the law regarding academic distress commissions and makes conforming changes throughout the Ohio Revised Code. (<i>Repealed</i> <i>R.C. 3302.10, 3302.101, 3302.102, 3302.11 and</i> <i>Sections 4, 5, and 6 of H.B. 70 of the 131st General</i> <i>Assembly; conforming changes in R.C. 133.06,</i> <i>3302.036, 3302.042, 3302.12, 3302.17, 3310.03,</i> <i>3311.29, and 3314.102</i>)
No provision.	Dissolves existing academic distress commissions and returns power to district boards of education in a school district for which an academic distress commission had been established. (<i>Section 5</i>)
