DETAILED ANALYSIS

License Plate	Ohio DeMolay license plate, which must display an appropriate logo and words selected by the representatives of Ohio DeMolay, and approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles. ¹	
Recipients	Available to all applicants.	
Eligible Vehicles	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar.	
Contribution; Additional BMV Fee; Use of Contribution	\$15 required contribution. \$10 additional administrative BMV fee. Contributions must be paid to Ohio DeMolay, which must use the contributions for scholarships, educational programs, and any other programs or events the organization holds or sponsors in Ohio. ²	
Requirements for Issuance	 Submission of an application; Payment of the regular license tax, any local tax, contribution, administrative fee, any special reserved license plate fee if necessary; and

Combined with Special Reserved License Plate	May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law.
Applicability of License Plate Termination Procedures	Procedures governing the termination of nonstandard license plates apply. ³
