DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"PFC William Boggs, CPL Sam Boggs, and SGT Robert Boggs Memorial Highway"
Highway	The northbound and southbound lanes of U.S. Route 62, between Staunton- Sugar Grove Road and Greenfield Sabina Road, in Fayette County.
Other Information	PFC William Boggs was killed in action on September 26, 1950 during the Korean War while trying to rescue fellow wounded soldiers. CPL Sam Boggs served in the U.S. Army during World War II and the Korean War and was inducted into the Ohio Military Hall of Fame in 2013. SGT Robert Boggs served in the U.S. Army during World War II and the Korean War. All three men received numerous medals and honors for their service.
