DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway indicating its name:

Designated Name	"Patrolman James A. Fredericka Memorial Highway" 1
Highway	The northbound and southbound lanes of State Route (SR) 7, between SR 82 and SR 305, in Trumbull County.
Other Information	Patrolman James A. Fredericka was a U.S. Army veteran of WWII and a state highway patrolman. He passed away on May 8, 1953, from injuries sustained eight days earlier when he lost control of his patrol car on a wet roadway and struck a tree while he was responding to a traffic accident.
