SUMMARY

Requires each school district to annually designate one valedictorian and one salutatorian from the senior class of each high school operated by the district.

DETAILED ANALYSIS

Designation of valedictorian and salutatorian

The bill requires the board of education of each city, local, and exempted village school district, except for an island school district, to annually designate one valedictorian and one salutatorian from the senior class of each high school operated by the district. 1

When determining the manner by which students are designated as valedictorian or salutatorian, the district board must consider completed coursework in the College Credit Plus Program or Advanced Placement or International Baccalaureate courses.²
