DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following three bridges and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers on the bridges or their approaches indicating their names:

Designated Name	"Canfield Armed Forces Bridge" 1
Highway	The bridge spanning State Route (SR) 11 along U.S. Route 224, located in Canfield Township, in Mahoning County.

Designated Name	"Canfield First Responders Bridge" ²
Highway	The bridge spanning I-76 along Herbert Road, located in Canfield Township, in Mahoning County.

Designated Name	"Lewis John Speece, Jr. Memorial Bridge" ³
Highway	The bridge spanning I-76 along SR 46, located in Canfield Township, in Mahoning County.
