SUMMARY

- Requires each school district and chartered nonpublic school to provide for an individual enrolling a student the opportunity to voluntarily state whether the student has a parent or guardian who is a member of the Armed Forces deployed or expecting to be deployed to active duty during the school year.
- Requires each school district and chartered nonpublic school to report to the Department of Education the total number of students for which that voluntary notice is given.

DETAILED ANALYSIS

Notice regarding active duty parent

The bill requires each school district and each chartered nonpublic school to provide for an individual enrolling a student an opportunity to voluntarily state whether the student has a parent or guardian who is a member of the Armed Forces deployed or expecting to be deployed to active duty during the school year. The opportunity must be provided at the time of enrollment and at any time during the school year.¹

Each district and chartered nonpublic school must report, in the manner prescribed by the Department of Education, the total number of students for which that voluntary notice has been given.²
