DETAILED ANALYSIS

License Plate	A Kid Again license plate, which must display an appropriate logo and words, selected by representatives of A Kid Again, Inc. and approved by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles. ¹
Recipients	Available to all applicants.
Eligible Vehicles	Any passenger car, noncommercial motor vehicle, recreational vehicle, or other vehicle approved by the Registrar.
Contribution; Additional BMV Fee; Use of Contribution	<p>\$25 required contribution.</p> <p>\$10 additional administrative BMV fee.</p> <p>Contributions must be paid to A Kid Again, Inc., which must distribute the contributions equally between the Ohio chapters of A Kid Again.²</p>
Requirements for Issuance	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Submission of an application;2. Payment of the regular license tax, any local tax, contribution, administrative fee, any special reserved license plate fee if necessary; and3. Compliance with all other relevant laws relating to motor vehicle registration.

Combined with Special Reserved License Plate	May be combined with a special reserved license plate provided in current law.
Applicability of License Plate Termination Procedures	Procedures governing the termination of nonstandard license plates apply. ³
