This table summarizes how the latest substitute version of the bill differs from the immediately preceding version. It addresses only the topics on which the two versions differ substantively. It does not list topics on which the two bills are substantively the same.

Previous Version (As Introduced)	Latest Version (I_133_0163-2)
Licenses that qualify as photo identification for voting purposes	
Specifies that a concealed handgun license qualifies as photo identification for voting purposes. ¹	Specifies that a county issued identification that includes a person's name, current address, photograph, and expiration date qualifies as photo identification for voting purposes if, in order to obtain that identification, the county required proof of county residency and presentation of a birth certificate, passport, or Ohio driver's license or state identification card. ²
