DETAILED ANALYSIS

The bill designates the following highway and bridge and authorizes the Director of Transportation to erect suitable markers along the highway and suitable markers on (or near) the bridge indicating their names:

Designated Name	"Purple Heart Trail of Defiance County" ¹	
Highway	The northbound and southbound lanes of State Route 66, in Defiance County.	
Designated Name	"Purple Heart Bridge" ²	
Bridge	The bridge on State Route 66, spanning the Maumee River and located in Defiance, Ohio, in Defiance County.	
Other Information	The Purple Heart medal is presented to military service members who have been wounded or killed as a result of enemy action while serving in the U.S. military. It originated from the Badge of Military Merit, created by President George Washington in 1782, and was revived with its modern-day look and name by Army General Douglas MacArthur in 1932.
